WHAT WE DIDN'T IMAGINE

A BUSY MONTH

This past month we found a place to rent for the church and immediately got to work on making the rectangular box a place to call home. After printing flyers we got a sign made, then went around the neighborhood sharing and inviting people to church. We are incredibly blessed to be near a park and two schools as well.

This Saturday we started on the first of a two part vision for the church. A free Bible club at the local park (the same park we've done two outreaches in) yielded 20 kids. After a Bible lesson the kids enjoyed a skit, craft and snack. It felt like VBS and we had a blast!

We will continue to use the Bible club to minister to the children in the neighborhood and also use it as a tool to build relationships and trust among the people. In our experience, when the children are being loved on and ministered to, the parents are sure to follow.

Part two of the vision for the church is to become as self-sustainable as possible through local economy. To do this, we hope to open a cafe that serves simple foods and offers a place the students feel comfortable meeting or just hanging out. This will provide more opportunity to build trust and relationships with the local people. Please pray for continued guidance and blessing in this vision.

WHAT ARE THE PRESSING NEEDS

We realize the Lord has not equipped everyone to support this ministry on a month to month basis, but just as the Body has different parts and functions that work together, so does the ministry. From time to time we have projects that call for an extra hand and so we ask you to please pray over the provision of these things and help spread the word.

Visas and Residency

It's time to renew our Religious Workers visa which means: documents, translation of documents, trips to the Notary, and waiting in lines. In total this costs us about \$500 each year.

Church Building

Up to this point we have put up walls for a kids class, and painted some of the walls. What's left includes about \$1,100 in tables, chairs, benches, and paint.

Local Missions

We have teams scheduled to visit over the coming months, and a few of the teams are Peruvians. It is much more affordable if they can stay at the church and cook their own food, so we are looking to buy a stove and refrigerator as soon as possible. Price for both appliances \$600.

HOLDING FAST TO HIS WORD

Hebrews 10:23 says, "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful." It is amazing to see the hand of God working through the circumstances of our lives and knowing that even when we are faithless, He is faithful.
